WORSHIP THEME - BEHAVIOUR Play the Right Way

This week in worship we have been reflecting on how the children behave in the classroom and how they behave on the playground. There was lots of good news to share about the children's classroom behaviour. The children are attentive, they work hard, help and support each other, are polite and helpful. However, just recently we have noticed that some of the children behave very differently when they are on the playground and we want to be able to be as proud of the children on the playground as we are when they are in the classroom.

We reminded the children of the importance of playing the right way and following our school values of kindness, the importance of being thankful and showing good manners in the dinner hall and having the courage to say when they see someone behaving in an unkind way.

The children were shown a PowerPoint provided by the Premier League which encourages children to Play the Right Way in all team games. We looked at how our values aligned and how it is not fun when children break the rules or are unkind to each other. Hopefully this will help all of the children to reflect on their behaviour at lunchtime.


CROSS COUNTRY CHARITY RUN


