WORSHIP THEME - Acts of Kindness

This week in worship we have been thinking about Random Acts of Kindness. Doing something kind to help or support someone when it is unexpected. We thought of lots of different things that we can do to help. The children have reported to me that they are doing the washing up, laying the table and making their bed—I hope this is true and you have seen some random acts of kindness at home too.

We have also been thinking about the importance of being thankful when someone helps us. To see just how kind and thankful we are all being we have started a paperchain of kindness—the aim is to try and get a paperchain of kindness going across each and every classroom and the school hall.

If someone does something kind for someone else we have asked that a thank you message is written on a strip of paper and added to the paperchain. I am really excited to see how big we can make our paperchains and what a kind and happy place this will make our school.




